Children's Church: Pre-school - 5th grade. Freda & Don Zickefoose lead this group.

They meet in the Children's Church room located down in the lower level of the Educational Building.

Halfway through our Sunday morning worship service, we dismiss the children for Children's Church. They worship the Lord together in an age appropriate setting. We are using the **SuperBook** video series and focusing on the Bible. We are learning and memorizing the books of the Bible along with memorizing Bible verses



Team Teachers Nursery Class: Infants - age 4. Teachers: Ruby Dalton and Jan Schmock. They meet in the nursery downstairs.

Spiritual nourishment by various teaching methods such as music, video's or CD's, interactive teaching of Bible stories, coloring, finger plays, with playtime given as needed.





Preschool Class: ages 4 - 2nd grade. Teacher: Lisa Cebull. They meet in The Ark Room

- The Gospel Light Curriculum is used. The fall lessons will cover, "I can lean about God", "I can know God loves me", and "I can show God's love".
- Many types of activities will be used to teach God's truth from the Bible. Such as role play, skits, puppetry, stories, coloring pages and learning proper manners for classroom and church etiquette, all age related.



Elementary Class: Grades: 3rd - 5th. Kelly Peschke. They meet in the Elementary Class Room.

• The Gospel Light Curriculum is used. This age will be challenged to hide God's word in their heart. They will also be learning to apply the Bible to their adventurous lives ahead of them.



Young Teen Youth Class: Grades: 9th - 12th. Teacher: Kathy Ravis. They meet in the youth room.

• This fall we will start with young teen curriculum by Davis C. Cook, with 4 goals for the quarter. They will learn the topic of the week presented, search the Bible to learn what it says, and making it real with application and how to use it personally. Some of the topics that will be presented will be, Being Real, Parables, and Making a Difference.

There will be 3 exciting Adult Classes meeting this fall. Please note you are welcome to attend any of these classes to learn the Bible and have fellowship with one another. These classes are considered as, open ended classes, which means that they will study according to the class pace for the day.
